October Science Experiments

1. "All Washed Up": Problem: What will happen to a man cut from newspaper when he is put into soapy water, compared to one put in plain water?

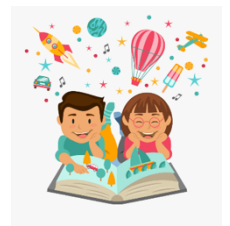
Answer: An absorbent material like newspaper will take a few seconds to become wet when placed in plain water, but will do so almost immediately when placed in soapy water. The newspaper man placed in soapy water will become wet and sink before the newspaper man that was placed in plain water.

2. "Surf's Up": Problem: What will happen when water is mixed with oil?"

Answer: The water and oil will separate. The oil always floats to the top because it is less dense than water. Oil and water don't mix because water molecules are more attracted to each other than to oil molecules.

We Will Learn Letters: Cc, Dd, Ee, and Ff

- The children will form the uppercase letters C, D, E, and F using their alphabet card and wood pieces.
- The children will hear and act out a song from Handwriting Without Tears entitled: "We Start Our Letters at the Top"
- The children will print the letters C, D, E, and F using the Foundations method.

Copacetic – Fine, completely satisfactory, OK.

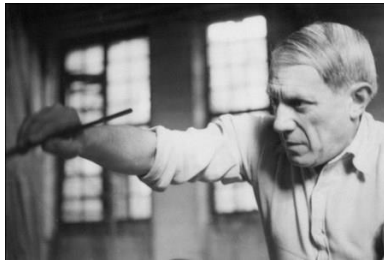
detrimental - intending to cause harm
