## New Year's Resolutions at the Giving Nest

We wish everyone a happy and healthy new year! The arrival of 2025 will be celebrated at the Giving Nest with noisemakers and confetti. Each class is challenged with a new skill to accomplish in 2025

The <u>Chickadees</u> (2  $\frac{1}{2}$  year old's) will begin to learn how to unpack their own backpacks. Upon arrival, with guidance from the teachers, the children will learn where the backpack is hung up and where to put their folder. After a few times it's amazing to see how quickly the children learn how to do this themselves.

The <u>Ducklings</u> (3 to 4-year old's) will begin getting their own coats at the end of the day and putting them on without any help. They will use the preschool method of laying the coats on the ground and putting their arms in the sleeves and flipping the coats over their heads (flip-flop over the top!).

The <u>Bluebirds and Cardinals</u> (4 to 5-year old's) will begin zippering, buttoning and/or snapping their own coats and putting on their hats and gloves all by themselves.

The <u>Kindergarteners</u> (5 to 6-year old's) will begin tying their shoes all by themselves. If your child has Velcro shoes, please consider buying tie shoes next time. We will also have shoe tying books in the classroom for the children to practice.

<u>January 21<sup>st</sup></u> In-House Pre-Registration information and form will be emailed to you. Please complete the online form link in the email no later than January 23<sup>rd</sup>. There will be an In-House lottery if necessary. You will be called if this should pertain to you.

January 29th: Look for the In-House Registration confirmation email. This is to confirm your Pre-Registration choice. Please fill out by February 13th. If you do not receive this information, please contact the office ASAP.

January 31<sup>st</sup> Calling all Alumni & new family's applications on file.
