Make Your Own Luck

Here's what we will be learning this month:

Literacy:

- Sounding out words in your head and saying the whole word aloud
- Consonants **Y, V, Z, Q** (letter sound and how to write)
- Sounds of **C** (when C says "k" or "s")
- Reading words with long vowels (CVCe pattern—magic e at the end makes the other vowel say its name)
- Reading Sight Words and using them in sentences
- Story Parts: focusing on Beginning, Middle & End
- Fiction / Nonfiction books (Real / Make Believe)

Math:

- Identifying & writing numbers 0-100
- Fact Families (How to make 5; e.g. 1+4, 2+3, 0+5)
- Comparing numbers (more/less using symbols > <)
- Coins: counting pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters

Science / Social Studies:

- Rainbows
- Force & Motion
- St. Patrick's Day

A Note from Mrs. Doherty

After report cards go out, please feel free to reach out if you would like a conference. The kids have been working hard to read our little books in school. I encourage you to find simple phonics books that interest them and read a book before bedtime. Short vowel books will support what they already know! We will start learning patterns for words that have long vowel sounds. These words typically have 2-vowels, with the first vowel saying its name or the long sound. Reading at this stage is all about finding the patterns and enjoying books that the children are interested in reading!
